

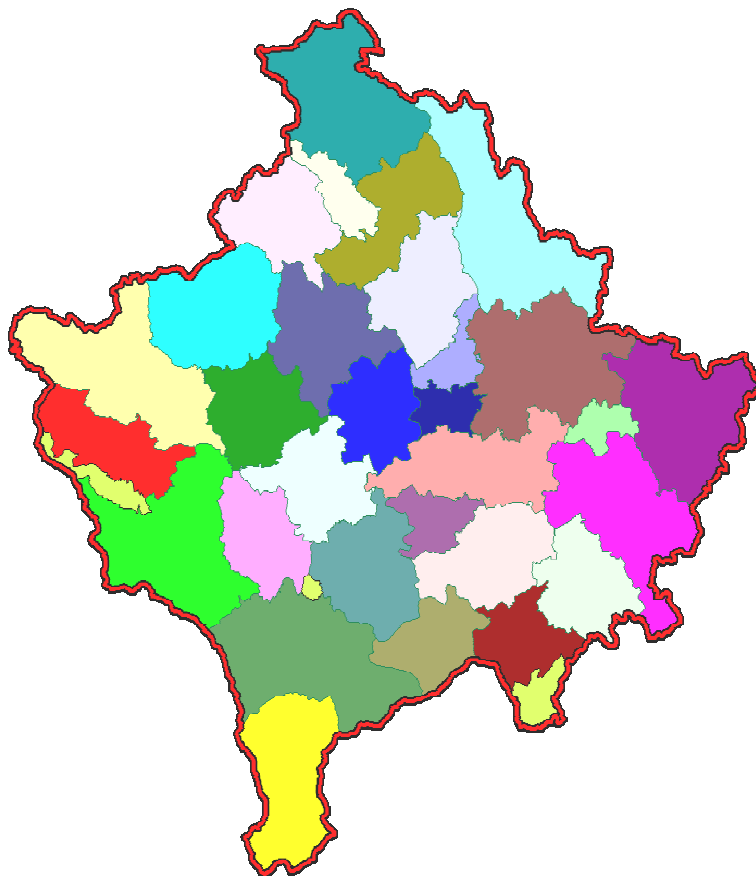

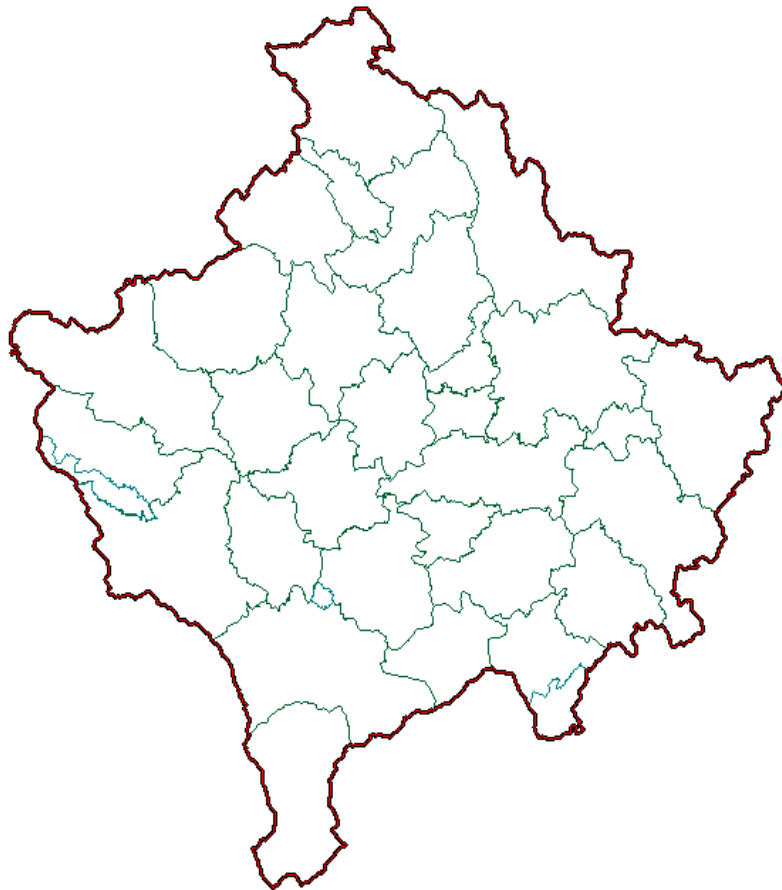

F o r e w o r d

In this bulletin, the Statistical Office of Kosovo (SOK) publishes the basic data and some indicators for deaths, in Kosovo for 2010.

Data in this bulletin are final thereof are results of monthly regular researches, whereas the data processing and the publication is annually.

Sources of data for death statistics are registry books, for deaths, while reported units are the Civil Status offices of Kosovo (registrars).

Data collection was conducted through special statistical instrument: statistical questionnaire for deaths - DEM-2.

According to the law provisions on managing the registry books, cases of deaths are mandatory to be registered in registry books for deaths in the place where the event occurred, not considering whether the persons who are related with the event have their permanent residence in that location or elsewhere.

The data of demographic statistics for deaths are processed and published according to the principle of the mother's permanent/usual residence which according to the international rules corresponds to the concept of permanent population (residence), a principal which is also applied in the population census.

In case of using this information published in this bulletin, the Department of Population Statistics will accept suggestions, proposals and any eventual remark that will help to affluence the content of this publication in the future.

Brief history

During 1900-1912, the data for deaths were obtained through the Turkish registers that were administered in special administrative offices and in religious institutions.

Also during the period of 1921-1939, the data for vital statistics were mainly obtained through records maintained by religious institutions (churches and mosques). A small amount of data was obtained through civil status or state registry offices.

After the Second World War, on 9th of May 1946, the Law on Marriages and Law on State Registry Books were approved and this matter passed to competency of state bodies.

Collection of data for births was conducted on a monthly basis by registrars in the summary review for the dead person, which contained only the total and the gender. The collected monthly data were *p r e l i m i n a r y* demographic results.

After 1951, demographic data were collected through individual questionnaire which afterwards were processed, and thus the *f i n a l* data were obtained according to the permanent residence and the time when the case occurred.

The destruction of the demographic system of statistics starts with the beginning of political disorders in Kosovo in 1989, while the total collapse happened during the war in 1999 and continued with the disorder and destruction of many registry offices and the liquidation and stealing-withdrawing of many registry books in Serbia (in some municipalities including the registry books from 1900).

First efforts to start the operation of this institution were made in the end of 1999 when UNMIK establishes new civil register and thus by giving life to new registry book and certificates.

In 2000, the priority was "Reactivation of the Vital Statistical System" planned in the Department of Population Statistics in SOK. General technical assistance was provided by the Montreal University in Canada and later from the Holland Government.

In August of 2001 starts the data collection for deaths.

Demographic Statistics, after the war of 1999, were initially supported by CIDA (Canadian International Development Agency) for the first phase, and the Government of Holland for the second phase – UNFPA was as an executive agency of the project.

Data source

Reporting units of data for deaths are the offices of civil status (registry offices). Data are collected by the special statistical questionnaire DEM -2.

According to the law provisions on administering the registry book, death cases are mandatory to be registered in registry book, at the seat clerk or registry office where the event occurred, not considering whether the persons to whom the event is related live in that place or in any other place.

The outcomes of demographic statistics are processed according to the permanent residence principal of the dead person. Thus, the demographic statistical outcomes are

processed according to the permanent residence principal that corresponds with the concept of permanent population (resident) applied in the population censuses.

This bulletin contains information related to vital phenomena that occurred in 2008 and are presented in tabulation format, on the country and municipality level for natural and violent deaths, according to the main characteristics such as age, gender, ethnicity, education qualification, etc.

Scope / coverage

After the war in 1999, it has been estimated that the cases of vital statistics –deaths– were included in around 75%.

It is of special importance the implementation of legal regulatory on registration of vital cases (deaths) in the registry books, in the civil status offices.

Vital events occurred in the settlements with Serbian majority, mainly are not registered at the Civil Status Offices of Kosovo. Therefore, DSP of SOK does not possess information for that part of the population of Kosovo.

Elementary analysis

Based on data presented in the tables of this bulletin for 2010, mortality is 3.3 per thousand (promil).

Based on information collected in this publication, reported by family members and registered in the registration books for the deaths, in 2010, Kosovo were registered 7234 deaths, of whom 4263 or 58.9% males and 2971 females, or 41.1%. 45.7% of cases of deaths have occurred in health institutions, while 54.3% occurred at home or elsewhere.

According to the municipality where the event happened, Pristina takes first place with 2182 cases of deaths or 30.1%, second place Prizren with 770 or 10.6%, third Gjilan with 463 or 6.4% etc. 73.4% of the dead were aged 60 and more years.

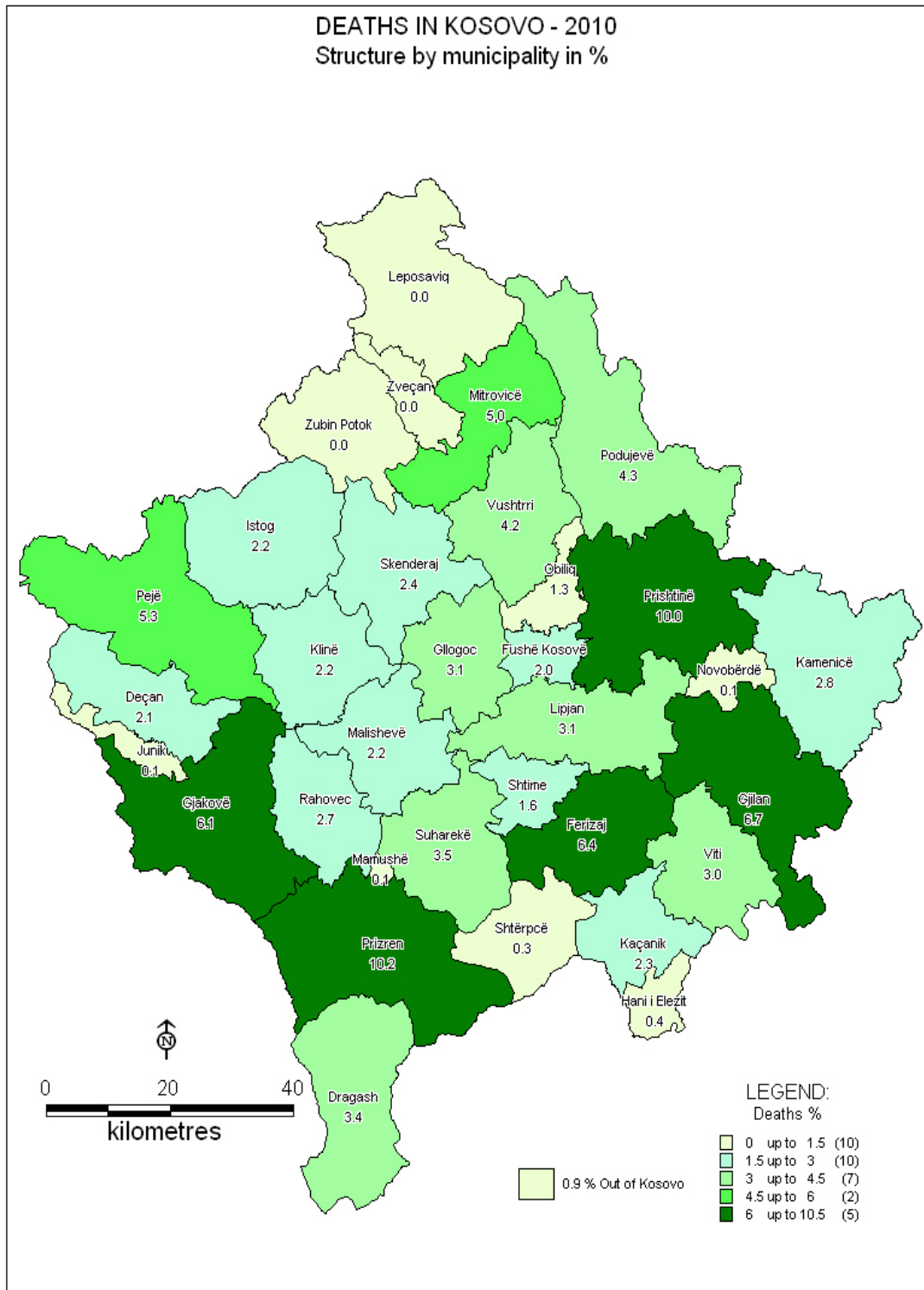
The first quarter of the year participates with 27.0%, while the month of January takes first place with 9.5%. Albanians participate with 93.6%.

Violent death in 2009 had a total of 203 cases or 2.9%. 159 cases of fatalities or 78.3%, 12.3% or 25 suicides and murders 19 or 9.4%. In all violent deaths dominates age 20-49 years old to men and women.

Infant deaths for 2009 were 288, and their participation in total deaths is 4.1%. Males 156 or 54.2%, Females 132 or 45.8%.

Perinatal deaths - up to 6 days were 179 or 62.2%, neonatal deaths - 7 to 27 days were 38 deaths or 13.2% and postneonatal - 28 days to 1 year were 71 or 24.7% infants.

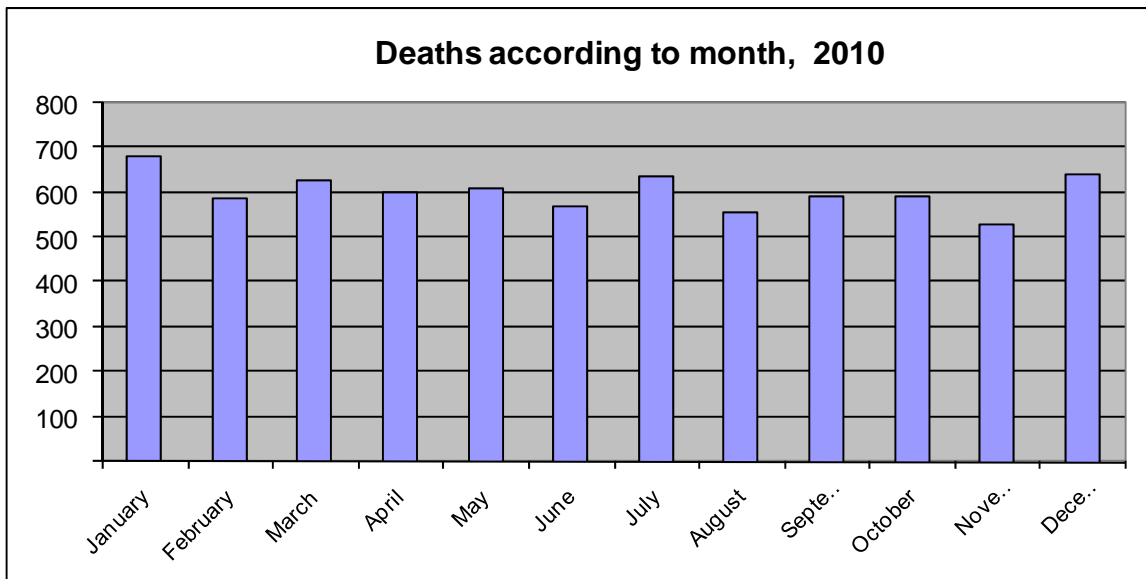

short description

Statistical Office of Kosovo is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Office has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

Statistical Office of Kosovo operates under Regulation 2001/14 which entered into force on 2 July 2001. Law on official statistics is in process for approval. Strategic development plan 2009-2013 is the middle term implementation for the development of statistical system in correlation with the European Union statistics (EUROSTAT). **Statistical Office of Kosovo** has this organizational structure: production departments; (Department of Economic statistics and National Accounts, Department of Population statistics, Department of Agriculture and Environmental statistics and Department of Social statistics. **Support Departments;** (Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Administration. **Within the Office we also established** Office of the Population Census, Households and Dwellings. **Regional Offices;** Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Prishtina and Ferizaj

Number of employees and budget are still limited. Employees are total of 134 workers, of them 96 (71.6%) at the headquarters of the Office, while in the Regional Offices, 38 (28.4%), with qualifying structure, 65.4% with university education to 34.6% with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNVEF, and the statistics of countries in the region.

Statistical Office of Kosovo almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

We have successfully implemented the project of Population Census, Households and Dwellings in 2011, Census that was not carried out since 1981. Results obtained from the Census will have an important role in compiling the development policies.

The mission of the Office; to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.
