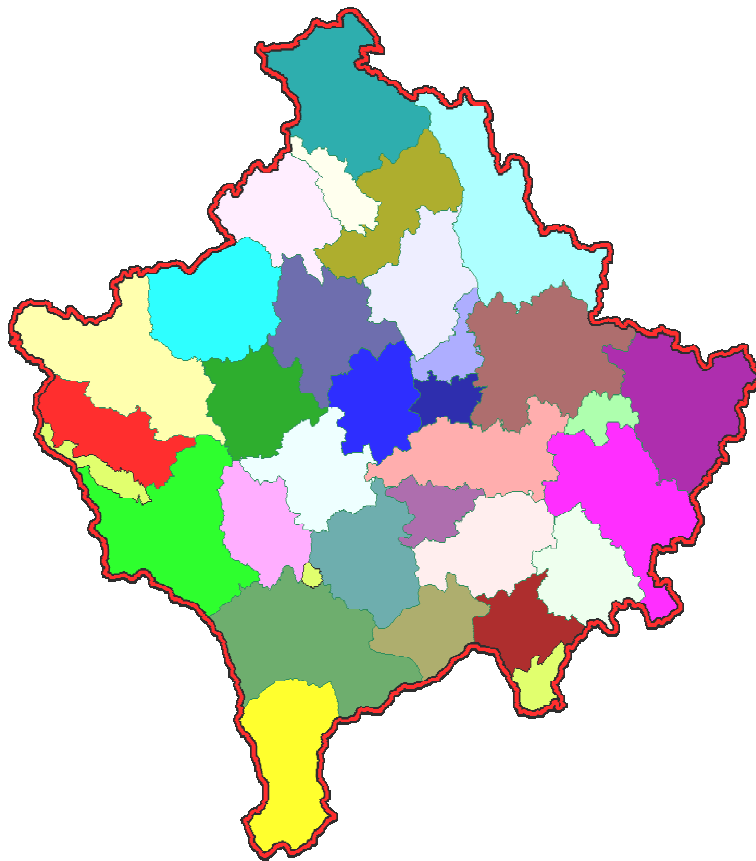

F o r e w o r d

The Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) started to publish the data for the Import of Kosovo since 2001.

Publication of External Trade is based on the data provided by the Kosovo Customs Service and Kosovo Electric Corporation on electricity.

Data in this publication differs from the preliminary data published previously.

This annual publication composes of 27 tables for External Trade of Kosovo, with some comparisons with years 2010 - 2011. Tables are in regard of export and import according to the flow of goods, sections, countries, border points and articles.

Imports are presented according to the origin of the country.

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Export and Import flow during 2011

Analyzing the data for the period of 2005 - 2011, it can be notified that there is a permanent growth (increase) of export and import.

Trade deficit in 2011 was 2,173,1 million Euros which reflects a negative balance also in this year. The total of export in 2011 was 319,1 million euros, whilst the import was 2,492,3 million euros, the export covers the import 12.8%.

This publication gives more explanations and details on what our country imports from the external market and what exports to the external market (trade).

Comparing the data of 2011 with 2010 for some main groups of goods, it can be seen that the annual increase of the export is for 8% higher. The main components of the export for 2011 are: chemical products increased from 2,4 million euros to 4,1 million euros (72%), machinery and transport equipment from 9,7 million euros to 16,1 million euros (66%), beverages and tobaccos from 5,3 million euros to 8,0 million euros (51%), mineral fuels from 10,8 million euro to 16,2 million euro (50%), commodities and transactions not classified else from 91 thousand euros to 131 thousand euros (45%), crude materials from 73,9 million euros to 81,1 million euros (10%), manufactured goods classified increasing from 165,9 million euros to 168,7 million euros (2%), and there is a decrease in the group of: animal and vegetable oils from 100 thousand euros to 45 thousand euros (-55%), miscellaneous manufactured from 8,7 million euro to 6,9 million euros (-21%), food and live animals from 18,7 million euros to 17,5 million euros (-6%).

Regarding the imports, the annual increase in 2011 has been 16%. Main components of the imports are: mineral fuels from 339,2 million euro to 452,4 million euro (33%), crude materials from 65,8 million euro to 86,3 million euro (31%), commodities and transactions not classified else from 9,4 million euros to 12,4 million euros (31%), chemical products increased from 205,0 million euro to 256,6 million euro (25%), food and live animals from 354,3 million euro to 413,0 million euro (17%), manufactured goods classified 421,8 million euro to 488,8 million euro (16%), beverages and tobaccos from 102,0 million euros to 114,4 million euros (12%), miscellaneous manufactured from 202,5 million euro to 226,5 million euro (12%), animal and vegetable oils from 17,3 million euro to 19,2 million euro (11%), and there is a decrease in the group of: machinery and transportation equipment from 439,8 million euro to 422,3 million euro (-4%).

Regarding the export - import of Kosovo, the main trade partners are Balkan countries participating with 26.0% for export and 35.1% for import comparing with the total of the year 2011, while EU participation has been with 42.8% for export and 38.0% for import comparing with the total of the year 2011. Regarding the exports of Kosovo with Balkan countries, Albania participates with 10.8%, Macedonia with 9.7%, Serbia with 2.3% comparing with the total of the year 2011, and the major participants of the imports in Kosovo from the Balkan countries are Macedonia with 14.7%, Serbia with 10.2% and Albania 3.9%.

External Trade Statistics – methodological notes

Sources

The statistics of trade is compiled mainly from the documents supplied by importers and exporters (or their agents) to the Customs authorities. The document is the *Single Administrative Document* (SAD) used for Customs clearance purposes. The information on the document is captured by the Customs Information system. The additional source of data are administrative data for imports and exports of electricity.

Responsibility for data collection, compilation and publication

The Customs Administration is responsible for the collection, inputting and processing of customs declarations data. SAD records with statistical fields are reported monthly to the Statistical Office by the Customs Administration on electronic media.

KAS is responsible for external trade data collection, compilation and publication. Statistics defines the coverage of statistics by kinds of customs procedures. The additional work involves editing and validation of customs data.

Coverage

External trade statistics does not cover temporary imports and exports of goods which will return after a certain period in an unchanged condition, services, repairs, money as means of payment, monetary gold, fuel supply of Kosovo's vehicles abroad, imports of goods for foreign liaisons and other diplomatic missions in Kosovo, personal baggage of travellers, commercial samples and postal packages of minor value.

Recording system

External trade statistics are compiled in accordance with the 'special' system (**relaxed definition**) of recording international trade. Under this system imports and exports are recorded at the time the goods are moved across the free circulation area, that is, the part within which goods may be disposed of without customs restriction. **Relaxed definition means** that beside regular import and export transactions also inward and outward processing are included.

Special imports consist of imports of foreign goods into the free circulation area for consumption, for processing and after outward processing.

Special exports include exports of goods originating in the free circulation area, goods after inward processing and goods for outward processing.

Goods in transit are excluded.

Valuation

For imports the *cif* value (inclusive of cost, insurance and freight to the point of entry to the Kosovo) is used. For exports the *FOB* (free on board) value is used. This is the cost of goods to the purchaser abroad, including packing, transport in the State, loading charges, insurance and all other charges accruing up to the point where the goods are put on board the exporting vessel or aircraft or are conveyed to the land frontier. The invoice value is recalculated to the value at the Kosovo's border by adding or subtracting on whole or in part costs of transport, loading, unloading and insurance, depending on terms of delivery set down in the contract.

The value excludes:

- any sums receivable by the exporter by way of export refund, drawback, subsidy or other bounty
- any foreign customs duties or freight charges beyond the port or point of exportation.

Valuation is in euro. For transactions in which the value is expressed in a foreign currency, conversion to euro is done using the daily current exchange rate.

Reference period

The calendar month is the basic period for compiling the data. On the base of customs data the time of recording the imports/exports transactions is the date of submission of the customs declaration or according to some other date valid for the implementation of the customs regulations.

Units of quantity

The quantity of exported and imported goods is shown in net mass if it can be determined considering the nature of the product and in the supplementary unit of measurement when it is prescribed in the customs tariff nomenclature.

Net weight is the usual unit of quantity shown. The weight of containers, cases, jars and packing materials is therefore excluded.

Other units of quantity are used for some commodities, notably live animals, motor vehicles, office machines, domestic appliances, watches and clocks, and clothing (where number is used as the unit of quantity), footwear (where the number of pairs is used), floor coverings (where square metres are used), and beverages (where volume is used).

Partner country

In this publication, imports are recorded *by country of origin* (as opposed to country of consignment or dispatch). Goods obtained or produced in one country originated in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last substantial manufacturing process was done. Packing, repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

Exports are classified *by country of final destination*. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the goods will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

Country classification

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set out annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. From January 1999, this follows the United Nations' ISO alpha-2 coding system, in which each country is identified by a two letter code.

Commodity classification

Statistics are collected using the 8-digit Combined Nomenclature (CN) – the EU's tariff and statistical nomenclature. This nomenclature is managed and updated annually by the Commission in co-operation with the member states. The CN is aligned with the 6-digit

Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) – the nomenclature of the Customs Co-operation Council that is used throughout the world for applying customs tariffs and compiling external trade statistics. The CN contains about 10,400 8-digit subheadings, the first six digits of which correspond to the HS code.

The Standard International Trade Classification , Revision 3 (SITC Rev 3) has been developed by the United Nations for the advancement of the international comparability of statistics on external trade.

SITC Rev 3 contains about 3,100 basic headings (5-digit). These are combined into 261 Groups (3-digit), 98 Divisions (2-digit) and 10 Sections (1-digit). For example, Section 6 (Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material) consists of 9 Divisions, 61 to 69. Division 64 (Paper, paperboard and articles thereof) consists of two groups, 641 and 642, which together consist of 72 basic headings, such as 642.94 (Paper handkerchiefs, towels, tablecloths, garments etc).

SITC Rev 3 follows the structure of the HS. Each of the categories in the SITC (including all the basic headings) is equivalent to a combination of HS headings (and therefore to a combination of CN headings)

Dissemination of data

Monthly data are **provisional until** the release of final data and are published 40 days after the reference month.

Annual data are published twice: the first time as provisional data within the regular time delay and the second time as final data (in June for the previous year).

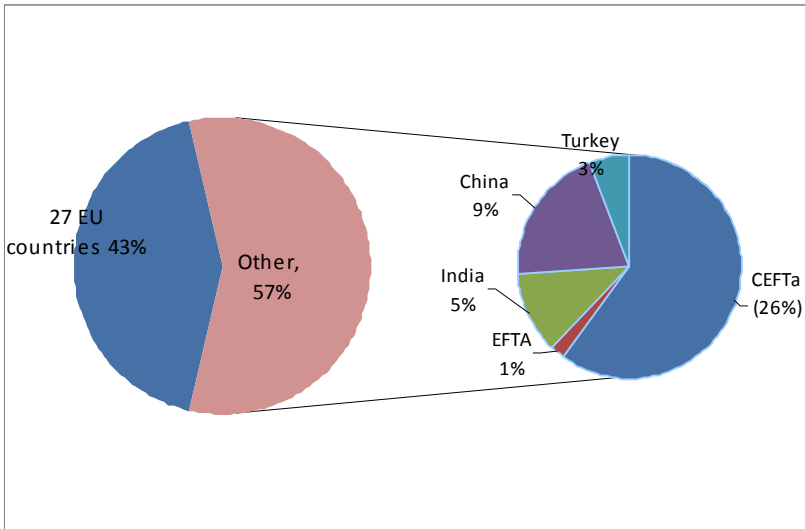

Graphic 3: The main trade partners for export 2011

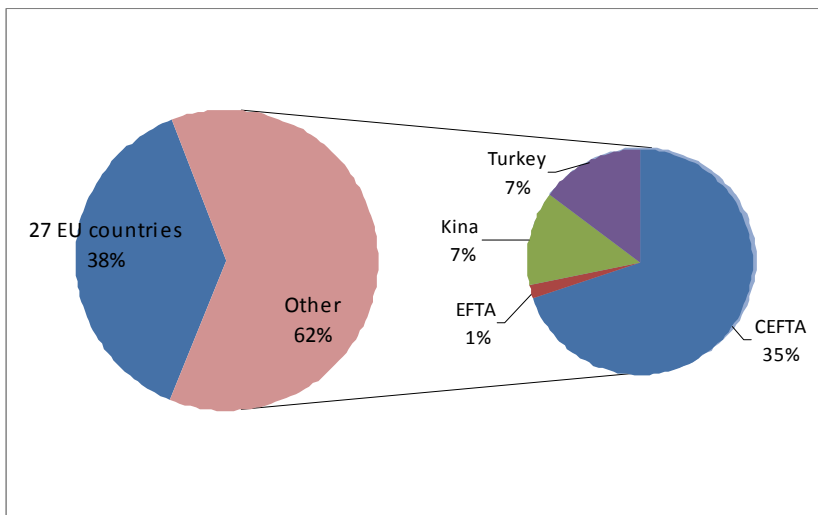

Graphic 4: Main partners in Kosovo in 2011

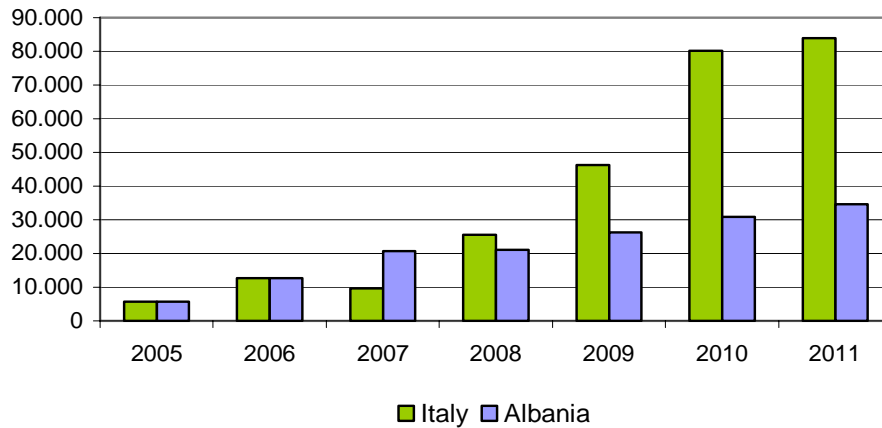
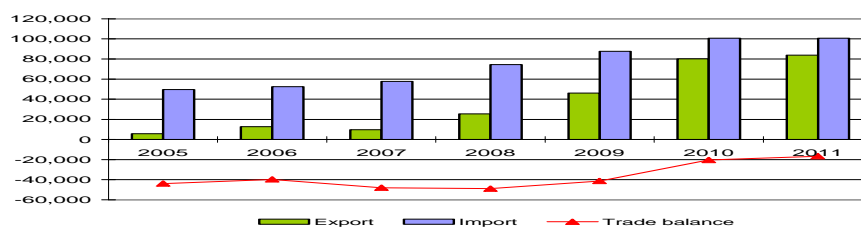

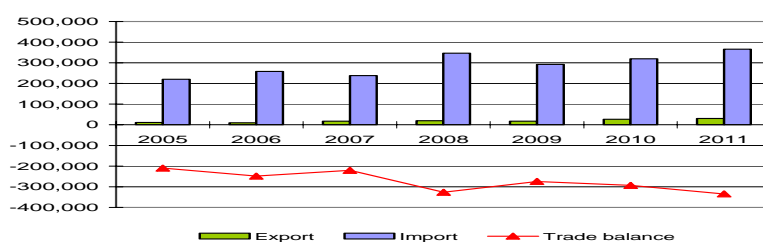

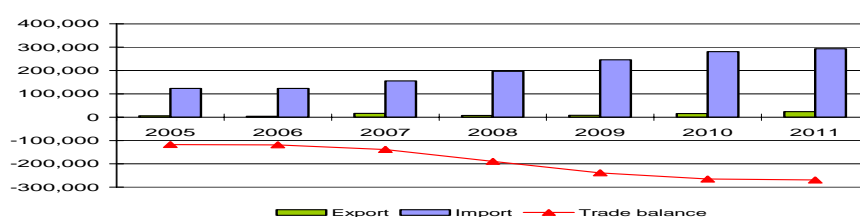

Graphic 9: Graph presentation of the trade with Germany**Main products in trading with Germany**

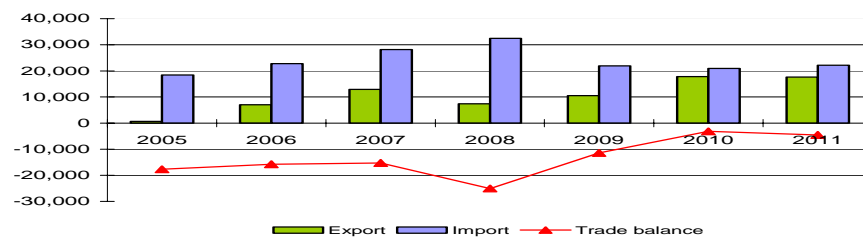

Kosovo Agency of Statistics

short description

Kosovo Agency of Statistics is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Agency has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Since 12.12.2011 the Agency operates in the frames of the Prime Minister's Office. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

Kosovo Agency of Statistics acts according to the Law No. 04/L-036 which entered into force on 12.12.2011. Strategic development plan 2009-2013 is the middle term implementation for the development of statistical system in correlation with the European Union statistics (EUROSTAT).

Kosovo Agency of Statistics has this organizational structure: production departments; (Department of Economic statistics and National Accounts, Department of Population statistics, Department of Agriculture and Environment statistics and Department of Social statistics. **Support Departments;** (Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Administration. **Within the Agency we also established** Office of the Population Census, Huseholds and Dwellings. **Regional Offices;** Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Pristina and Ferizaj

Number of employees and budget are still limited. Employees are total of 134 workers, of them 96 (71.6%) at the headquarters of the Agency, while in the Regional Offices, 38 (28.4%), with qualifying structure, 65.4% with university education to 34.6% with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNIVF, and with the statistical institutions of the countries in the region.

Kosovo Agency of Statistics almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

We have successfully implemented the project of Population Census, Households and Dwellings in 2011, Census that was not carried out since 1981. Results obtained from the Census will have an important role in compiling the development policies.

The mission of the Agency; to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.

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
