

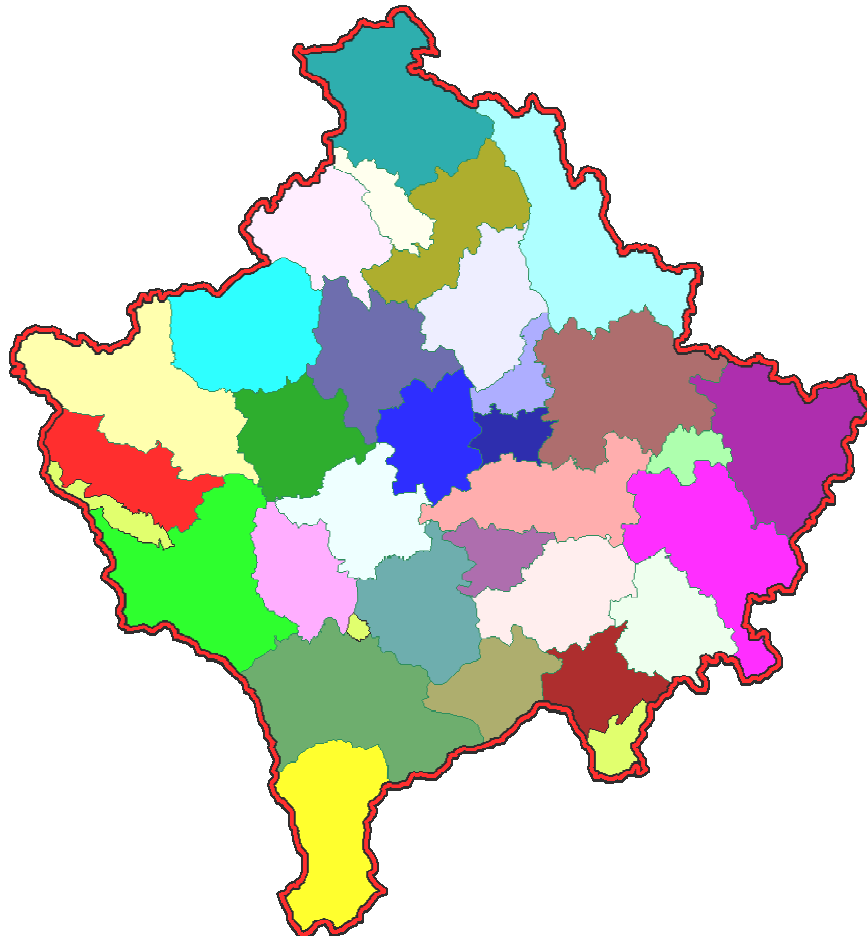

Statistical Office of Kosovo respectively Agriculture and Environment Statistics Department started to collect data on prices for agriculture input products in November 2003. In the beginning, prices were collected for a limited number of items (about 15 input items). At the moment prices for 68 different input items concerning agricultural input are collected. The plan for the future is to increase the number of agriculture input products.

This is the nine publications on Input Price Index for agriculture produced by Statistical Office of Kosovo (SOK). In this publication, Input Price Index for some major agriculture inputs is presented.

Agriculture Input Price Index

The publication includes data from Jul - September 2011 (Q3-2011). To make comparisons and to see changes also data from Q3 2005 -2011 2005=100 This publication is based on collection of prices for agriculture input products in Kosovo. The price collection was carried out at agriculture pharmacy enterprises, veterinary pharmacy enterprises, companies, markets, and other places where prices on agriculture input products are available. Some prices on agriculture input products we got from consumer prices (CPI) at SOK.

The products which make up the base for the Input Price Index are divided into two main groups: Goods and Services Currently Consumed in Agriculture (Input 1) and Goods and Services Contributing to Agriculture Investment (Input 2). Within Goods and Services Currently Consumed in Agriculture, prices are collected under the following groups; Seeds and Planting Stock, Energy; Lubricants, Fertilizers and Soil Improvers, Plant Protection Products and Pesticides, Veterinary Expenses, Animal Feeding stuffs, Maintenance of Materials, Maintenance of Buildings and Other Goods and Services. Within Goods and Services Contributing to Agriculture Investment, prices are collected for Materials (Machinery and Other Equipment), Buildings (Farm Buildings, other works except land improvements, other buildings, structures) and Other.

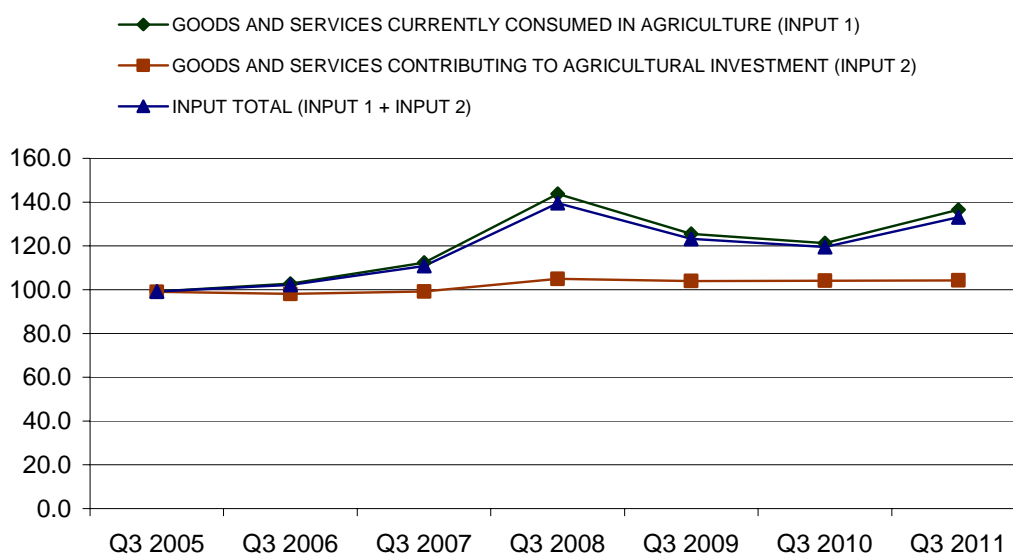
Figure 1 shows the second Quarter Input Price Index from 2005 - 2011 for Total Input as well as for Input 1 and Input 2 (2005 = 100).

The index changes in Q3 2011 compared to Q3 2010 (change in %)

In the third quarter 2011 the Input 1 has increased by 12.6 % compared to Q3 2010. The Index for **Input 2** has increased by 0.1 % compared to Q3 2010.

Total Input Index (**Input 1 + Input 2**) has also increased compared to Q3 2010 by 11.4 %.

Methodology

Prices and price indices in this publication have been calculated according standards for price statistics in European Union. The project for calculation these Prices and Indices was conducted in the frame of the project of "Improving agro monetary statistics" in cooperation with Statistic Sweden and with financial support by SIDA (Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency).

Prices are collected in seven regions: Pristina, Mitrovica, Peja, Gjakova, Prizren, Ferizaj and Gjilan. Prices are collected around the 15th in every month. Since the start the numbers of different prices that are collected have increased step by step.

The purpose of Agricultural Input Price Index is to follow the purchase prices of the means of agricultural production. By definition, the index does not cover factors of production. Thus, wages and wage costs, rent, interest payment, purchase of land and fixed asset animals are not part of the field of observation.

To compare the EU index presented in this publication with other countries, the Eurostat website is recommended (<http://epp.eurostat.ec.europa.eu/portal/page/portal/eurostat/home>).

Weights to calculate aggregated indices are mainly based on Agricultural Household Survey 2005, which is the base year in the index (2005=100). These weights are fixed as long as the base of the index is 2005. The index is a price index and is calculated on the basis of the Laspeyres formula.

Calculation of elementary Price Index

Calculations of elementary indices are in general done by using following formula, with un-weighted arithmetic mean price.

Calculation of aggregated Price Index

Calculating aggregated index for total Input or subgroups of Input Index is done using following formula.

Statistical Office of Kosovo

short description

Statistical Office of Kosovo is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Office has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

Statistical Office of Kosovo operates under Regulation 2001/14 which entered into force on 2 July 2001. Law on official statistics is in process for approval. Strategic development plan 2009-2013 is the middle term implementation for the development of statistical system in correlation with the European Union statistics (EUROSTAT). **Statistical Office of Kosovo** has this organizational structure: production departments; (Department of Economic statistics and National Accounts, Department of Population statistics, Department of Agriculture and Environmental statistics and Department of Social statistics. **Support Departments;** (Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Administration. **Within the Office we also established** Office of the Population Census, Households and Dwellings. **Regional Offices;** Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Prishtina and Ferizaj

Number of employees and budget are still limited. Employees are total of 134 workers, of them 96 (71.6%) at the headquarters of the Office, while in the Regional Offices, 38 (28.4%), with qualifying structure, 65.4% with university education to 34.6% with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNVEF, and the statistics of countries in the region.

Statistical Office of Kosovo almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

We have successfully implemented the project of Population Census, Households and Dwellings in 2011, Census that was not carried out since 1981. Results obtained from the Census will have an important role in compiling the development policies.

The mission of the Office; to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.
