Graph 1: Solution of the indictment in trial courts for juveniles in percentage (%)

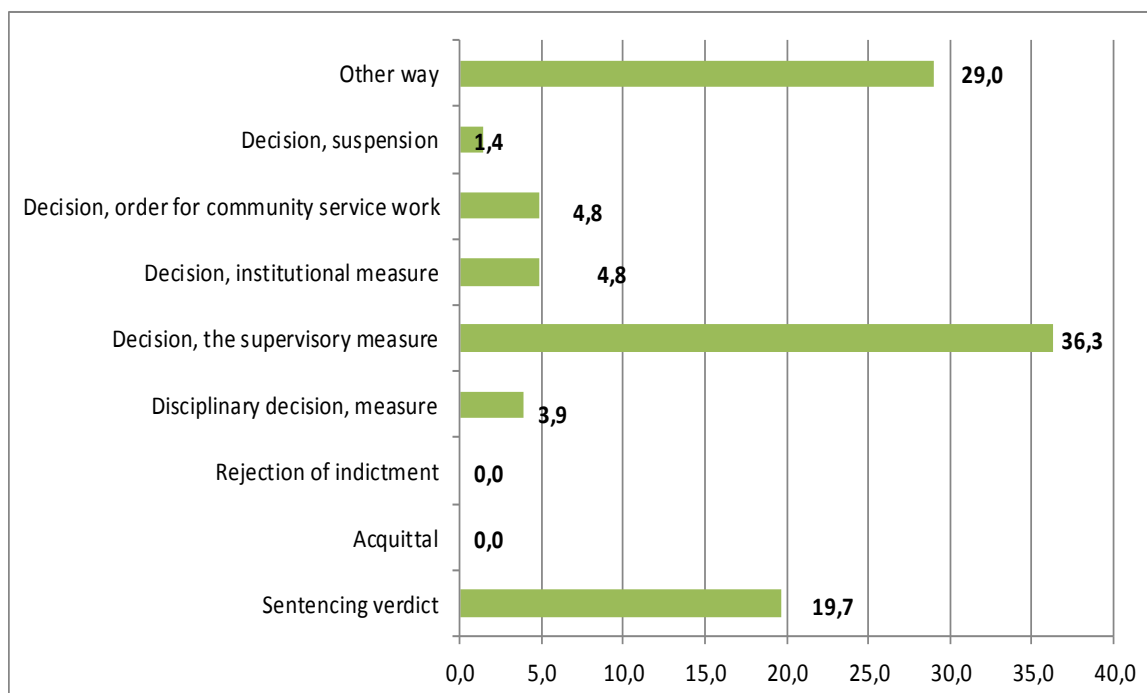

Graph 2: Juveniles accused in Basic courts by prosecution proposal, gender, expressed as a percentage (%)

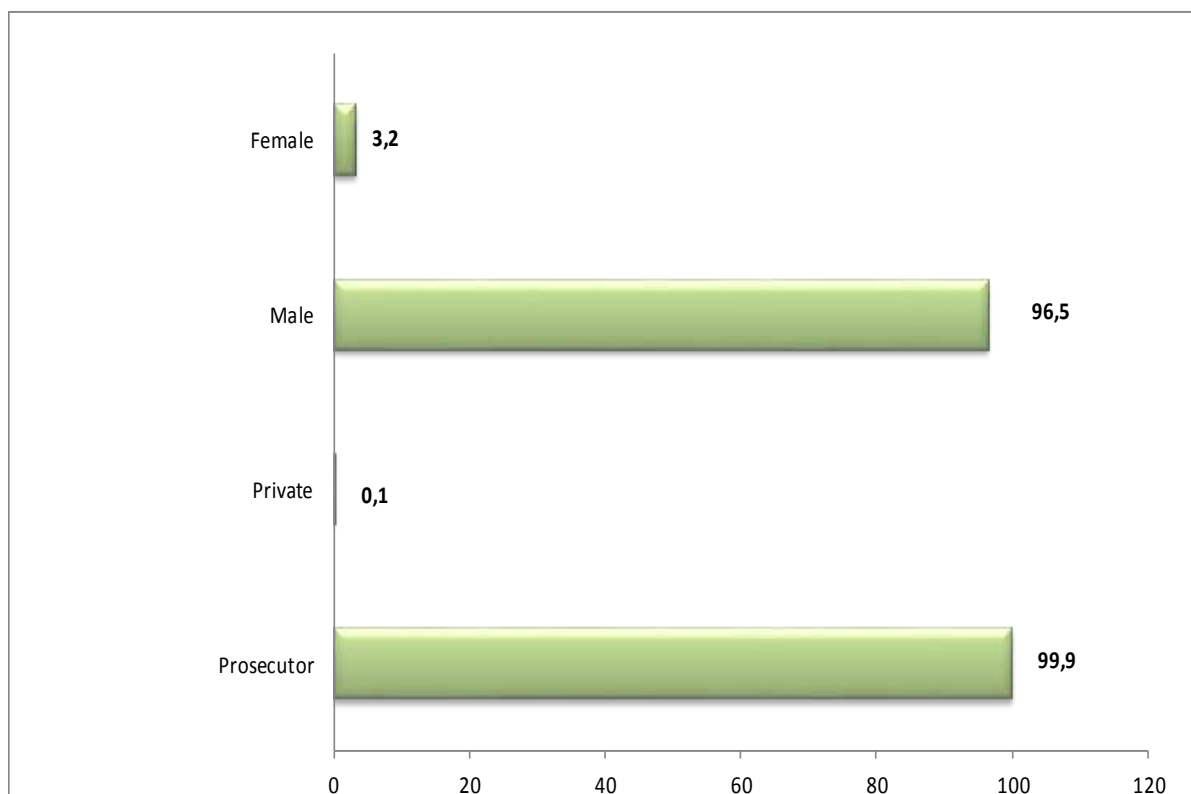

Graph. 3: Number of juveniles accused in Basic Courts according to nationality

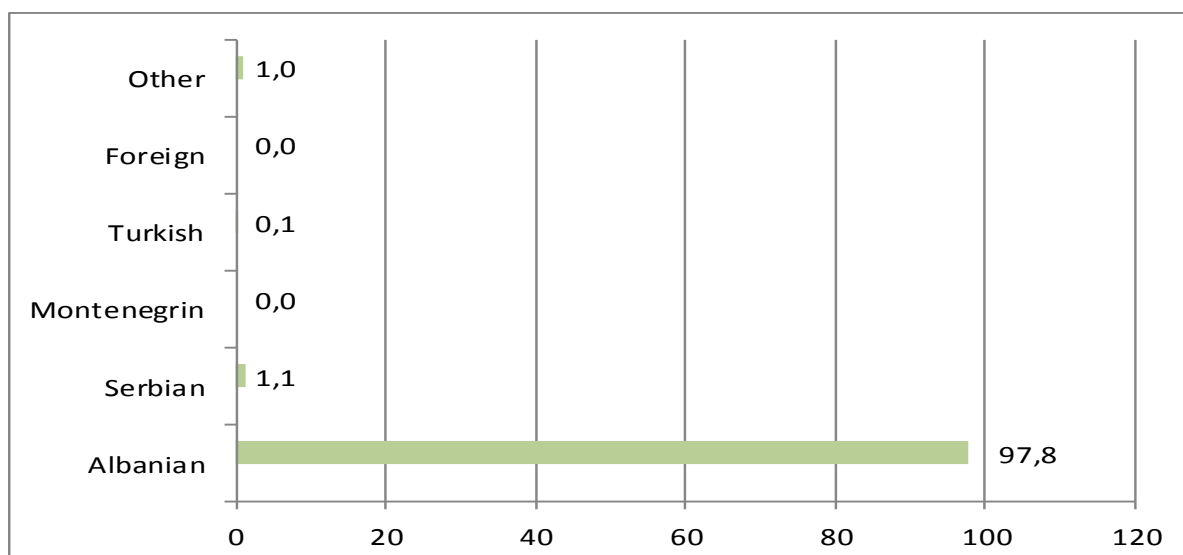

Graph 4: Number of juveniles convicted in Basic Courts in years 2003/2016

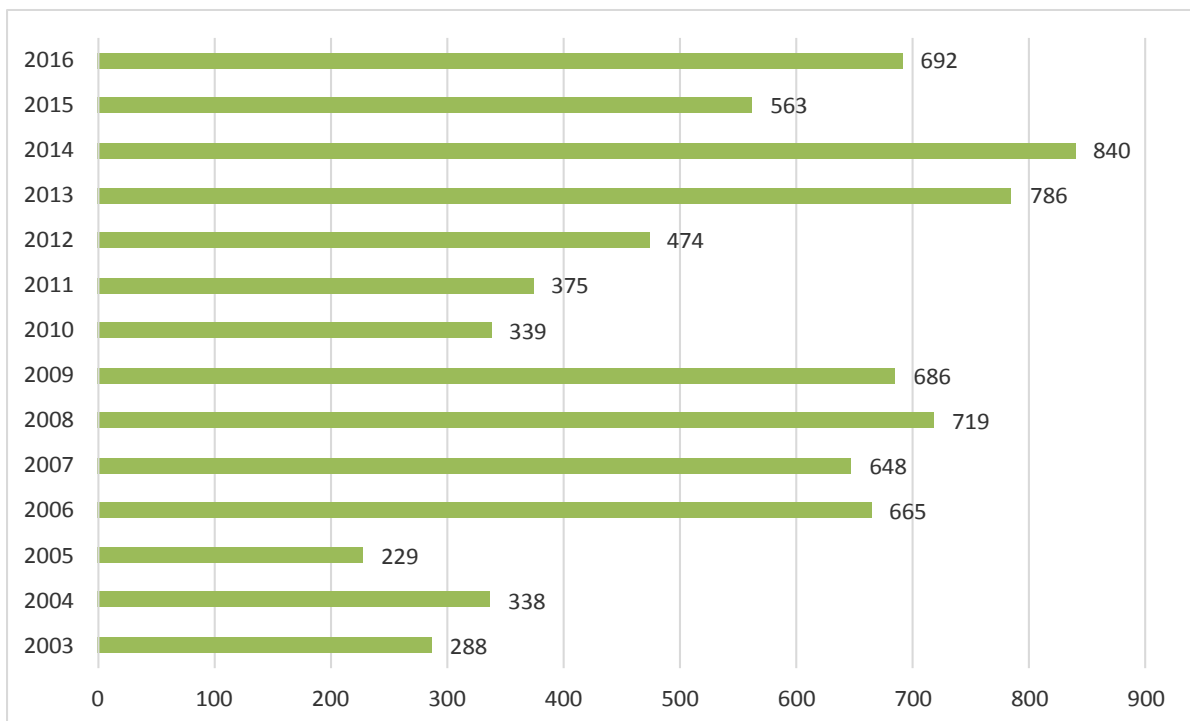

Graph 5: Number of juveniles convicted in the Basic Courts by gender and nationality

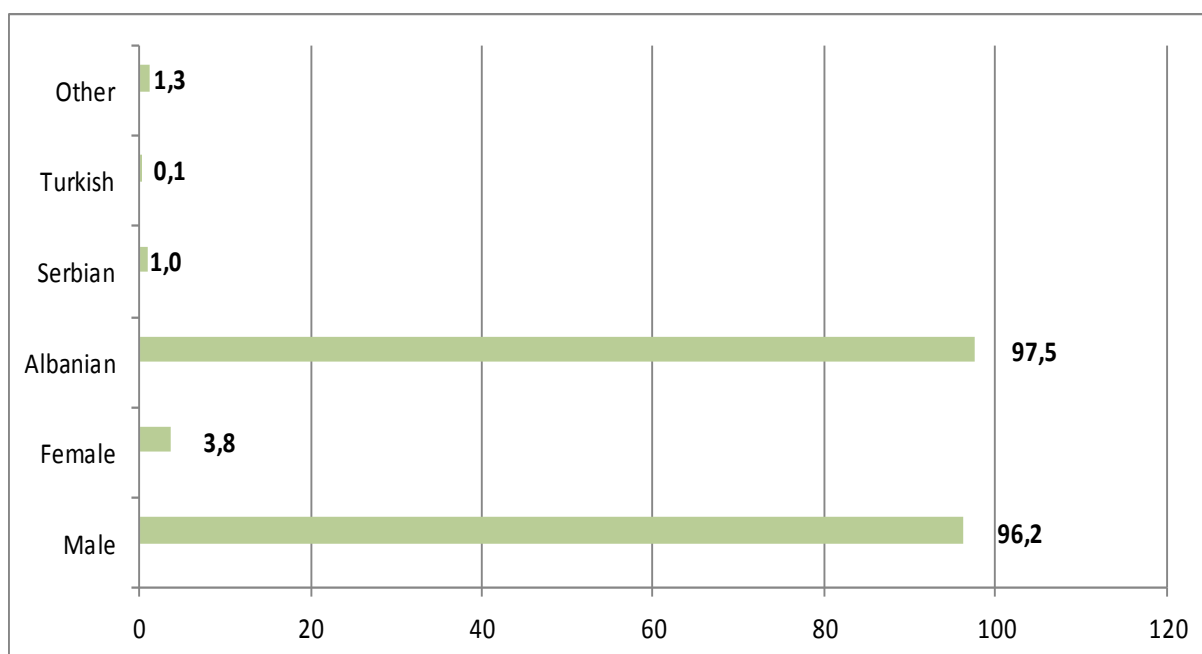
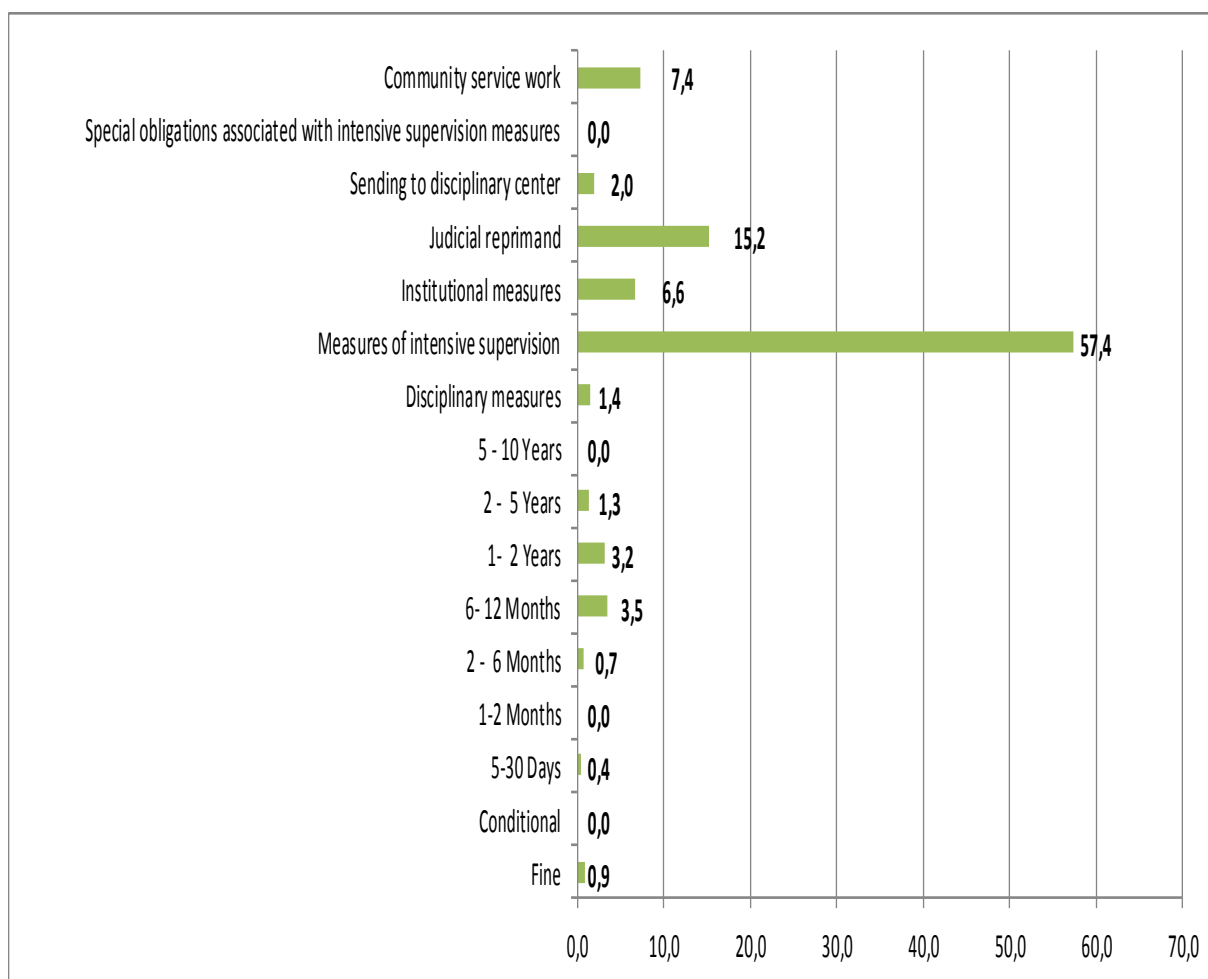

Explanations for the users

The law regulates the organization, functioning and jurisdiction of courts in the Republic of Kosovo

Established courts judge in accordance with the Constitution and the law into power.

The system of justice

Since 2013, publications are based on the new organizational structure of the judicial system.

According to the Law on Courts, this is the organizational structure of the courts of the Republic of Kosovo:

- Basic Courts,
- Appeal Court and
- Supreme Court.

Basic Courts

1. Basic courts are courts of first instance in the Republic of Kosovo.

There are seven (7) Basic Courts as follows:

Basic Court of Prishtina headquarters in Prishtina established for the territory of the Municipality of Prishtina, Fushe Kosove, Obiliq, Lipjan, Podujev, Glogoc, and Gracanica;

Basic Court in Gjilan headquartered in Gjilan established for the territory of Municipality of Gjilan, Kamenica, NovoBerdo, Ranillug, Partesh, Viti, Klllokot and Vërboc;

Basic Court in Prizren headquarters in Prizren established for the territory of the Municipality of Prizren, Dragash, Suhareke and Mamushë

Basic Court in Gjakova headquartered in Gjakova established for the territory of the Municipality of Gjakova, Malisheva, and Rahovec;

Basic Court in Peja headquartered in Peja established for the territory of Municipality of Peja, Decan, Junik, Istog and Klina;

Basic Court in Ferizaj headquartered in Ferizaj established for the territory of the Municipality of Ferizaj, Kacanik, Shtime, Shterpce and Hani i Elezit;

Basic Court in Mitrovica headquartered in Mitrovica established for the territory of the municipality of Mitrovica, South and North Mitrovica, Laposavic, Zubin Potok, Zvecan, Skenderaj and Vushtrria.

2. Appeal Court

The Appeal Court is established as a court of second instance, with the territorial jurisdiction throughout the Republic of Kosovo.

The seat of the Appeal Court is in Prishtina

3. Supreme Court

The Supreme Court is the highest judicial instance in Kosovo and has jurisdiction over the entire territory of Kosovo.

Observation unit of this publication are juveniles charged with criminal offenses.

With the notion perpetrator we mean the minor/juvenile offender whether as perpetrator, co-perpetrator, inciter or assistance.

A juvenile offender is a person who at the time of the commission of the offense has had 14 full years but has not attained age of 18.

Under the Code of Juvenile Justice we have this definition by age group:

- Minor - a person between the ages of fourteen (14) and eighteen (18).
- Young minor - a person between the age of fourteen (14) and sixteen (16).
- Adult minor - a person between the age of sixteen (16) and eighteen (18).
- Young adult - a person between the age of eighteen (18) and twenty (21).

The notion of offense¹

The offense is an unlawful act which is defined by law as a criminal offense, the characteristics of which are defined by law and for which the law stipulates criminal sanctions or measures of mandatory treatment.

Code of Juvenile Justice regulates the procedure of imposition and execution of measures and sanctions against minors, proceedings, and mediation procedure for minors.

Measures and convictions applicable to minors under this Code

I. Measures that can be imposed on minors are:

1. diversity measures and
2. educational measures.

Types of educational measures that may be imposed on a juvenile offender are :

- disciplinary measures,
- measures of intensive supervision and
- institutional measures.

II. Convictions hat may be imposed on minors are:

- fines,
- order for community service work and
- juvenile detention.

Against young minors aged from 14-16 years old may be imposed only educational measures. Basically, even on adult minors aged 16-18 years old may be pronounced educational measures, but in certain cases according to the law could be pronounced the sentence in prison for juveniles.

Classification of crimes

Classification of crimes (offenses) according to their nature is done by referring to the Criminal Code into force.

short description

Kosovo Agency of Statistics is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Agency has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Since 12.12.2011 the Agency operates in the frames of the Prime Minister's Office. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

Kosovo Agency of Statistics acts according to the Law No. 04/L-036 which entered into force on 12.12.2011. Programme of Official Statistics 2013/2017 is in implementation for the development of statistical system in correlation with the European Union statistics (EUROSTAT).

Kosovo Agency of Statistics has this organizational structure: production departments; (Department of Economic statistics and National Accounts, Department of Agriculture and Environment statistics and Department of Social statistics. **Support Departments**; Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Policy Planning, Coordination and Communication, Department of Census and survey and Department of Administration. **Within the Agency are also established Regional Offices**; Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Pristina and Ferizaj

Number of employees and budget are still limited. In KAS are employed in total 143 workers, of whom 98 (68,58 %) at the headquarters of the Agency, while in the Regional Offices, 45 (31,5%). Agency's educational qualifying structure is as follows: 61,7% with university education, 15,4% with with non-tertiary education, and 17.5% with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all Ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNICEF, and with the statistical institutions of the countries in the region.

Kosovo Agency of Statistics almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

In 2011, the project of Population Census , Households and Dwellings was successfully implemented, and in 2014 was successfully carried out the Agriculture Census. The result obtained from these censuses will have an important role in the development policies.

The mission of the Agency; to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.
