New results of ODIN 2017 are published - Kosovo's ranks the 8th in Southern Europe, and 68th in world level

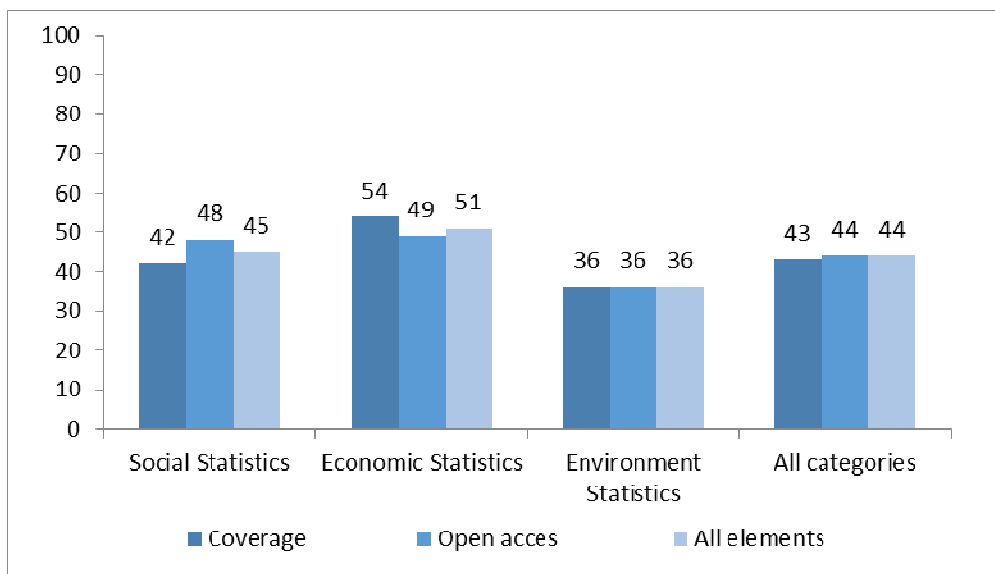
Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) has received the announcement of the publication of the latest Open Data Inventory annual report (ODIN 2017) for the dissemination of official statistics in open format, in the world-wide level

and continental division. This rating lists Kosovo at the 68th place on the world level and 8th in the Southern European level.

In the three areas surveyed, Kosovo appears to have made significant progress in the dissemination of statistics in open format compared to 2016, at the world level of 68th (which was 82nd in the ranking), as well as at the 8th in the Southern Europe (which was the 12th in the ranking). From the countries of Southern Europe, ODIN 2017, Kosovo leaves behind Croatia, Malta, Montenegro, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Andorra.

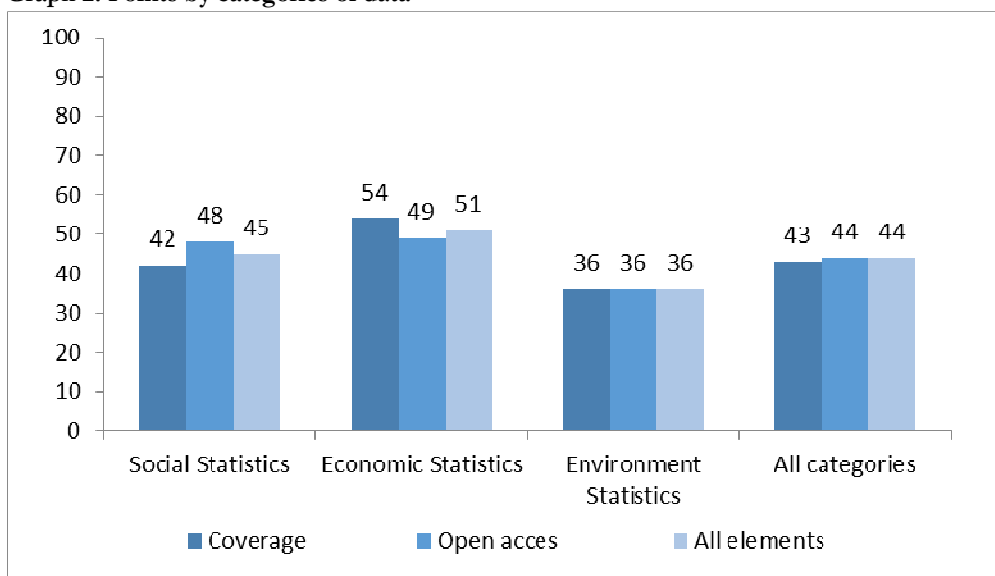
Graph 1: Kosovo's ranking at the Southern Europe and world level



In aggregated estimates of ODIN 2017 annual report, 21 categories and 10 elements are included, which characterize three main areas of assessment - social statistics, economic statistics and environment statistics. And, the results are divided on a scale from 0 to 100. In this assessment are presented 180 countries around the world, including most OECD countries. See worldwide rankings at:

Following the positive international assessment of the Kosovo Statistical System through the Peer Review 2017 report, this is also an extremely positive assessment for Kosovo in general and for KAS in particular.
