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## **F o r e w o r d**

The Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) has started to publish data on the flow of imports in Kosovo since 2002.

Publication of Kosovo International Trade is based on data from Kosovo Customs Service and Kosovo Energy Corporation for electricity.

The data in this publication are different from the preliminary data published for 2017.

This annual publication contains 22 tables for International Trade of Kosovo with some comparisons for the years 2016-2017. These tables deal with imports and exports according to the flow of goods, sectors, countries, border crossings and items.

Imports of goods are presented in accordance with the country of origin.

Compared with previous publications, in this publication are added some new tables which present our country's trade exchange with key partners.

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## Flow of export and import in 2017

In this publication of the statistics of trade in goods, more detailed explanations are given about what our country exports to the international market and what it imports from the international market.

Trade in goods in 2017 had trade deficit in the amount of Euro 2,669,0 million, which indicates a higher trade deficit by 7.6% compared to 2016, where this year Kosovo has a negative balance. Total exports in this year were Euro 378,0 million, while imports Euro 3,047,0 million. Export covers import by 12.4%.

Comparing data for exports in goods in 2017 with the year of 2016, figures indicates an annual increase by (22.1%), an increase which indicates a Kosovo's negative trade balance.

Exports by sections in this year were up in these groups: stone, plaster, ceramics and glass worth about 6.4 million euros (compared to 3.5 million euros or 1.7% of total exports with an increase by 81.3%), plant products worth about 23.4 million euros (compared to 16.7 million euros or 6.2% of total exports with growth by 39.7%), prepared foodstuffs, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco in the amount of about 36.8 million euros (compared to 27.6 million euros or 9.8% of total exports with growth by 33.4%), paper and paper products worth about 5.2 million euros (compared to 3.9 million euros or 1.4% of total exports with a growth by 31.0%), chemical industry products worth about 5.8 million euros (compared to 4.7 million euros or 1.6% of total exports with a growth by 25.0%), plastics, rubber and articles thereof in the amount of approximately 35.6 million euros (compared to 28.8 million euros or 9.4% of total exports with an increase by 23.4%), wood and articles of woods worth about 4.4 million euros (compared to 3.6 million euros or 1.2% of total exports with a growth by 21.8%), base metals and articles thereof in the amount of 135.4 million euros (compared to 111.1 million euro or 35.8% of total exports with a growth by 21.8%), transport vehicles worth about 1.7 million euros (compared to 1.5 million euro or 0.5% of total exports with an increase by 16.4%), mineral products worth about 72.6 million euros (compared to 63.8 million euros or 19.2% of total exports with a growth by 13.8%), textiles and articles thereof worth about 9.9 million euros (compared to 8.7 million euro or 2.6% of total imports with an increase by 13.2%), leather and articles thereof in the amount of 11.8 million euros (compared to 11.1 million euros or 3.1% of total exports with a growth by 5.7%), various manufactured articles in the amount of about 10.3 million euros (compared to 9.8 million euros or 2.7% of total exports with an increase by 5.5%).

During this period, exports decreased in these groups: footwear (footwear and parts of such items) in the amount of about 2.7 million euros (compared to 3.3 million or 0.7% of total exports with a decrease by 19.0 %).

The positive growth trend of exports from 2005 to 2017 has followed these groups of sections: prepared foods, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco from 4.5 million euros to 36.8 million euros, plastics, rubber and articles thereof from 968 thousand euro at 35.6 million euros, plant products from 2.8 million euros to 23.4 million euros, leather and articles thereof from 6.1 million euros to 11.8 million euros, paper and paper items from 379 thousand to 5.2 million euros.

Data on trade of goods in Kosovo Import in 2017 recorded an annual growth by (9.2%), compared with the previous year of 2016.

Growth of imports by sections was observed in these groups: mineral products (fuels) in the amount of about 442.6 million euros (compared to 327.5 million euros or 14.5% of total imports with an increase by 35.2%), means of transport (compared to 220.0 million euros or 8.8% of total imports with a growth by 21.6%), basic metals and articles thereof in the amount

of about 307.1 million euros (compared to 275.3 million euros or 10.1% of total imports with an increase by 11.5%), live animals, products of animal origin in the amount of about 121.4 million euros (compared with 109.8 million euros or 4.0% of total imports with an increase by 10.5%), paper and paper articles worth about 46.0 million euros (compared to 41.7 million euro or 1.5% of total imports with 10.4% increase), leather and articles thereof in worth about 9.0 million euros (compared to 8.3 million euros or 0.3% of total exports with an increase by 7.4%), wood and articles thereof worth about 77.1 million euros (compared to 72.6 million euros or 2.5% of total imports with a growth of 6.3%), prepared foodstuffs, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco in the amount of about 395.8 million euro (compared to euro 373.0 million or 13.0% of total imports with 6.1% growth), products of the chemical industry in the amount of about 230.4 million euros (compared with 221.5 million euros or 7.6% of total imports with 4.0% growth), footwear (footwear and parts of such items) in the amount of about 36.2 million euros (compared to 35.0 million euros or 1.2% of total imports with 3.5% growth), plastics, rubber and articles thereof in the amount of 194.2 million euros (compared to 188.4 million euros or 6.4 % of total imports with 3.1% growth), textile and textile articles worth about 139.9 million euros (compared to 136.6 million euros or 4.6% of total imports with 2.4% increase), machinery, mechanical and electrical equipment worth about 361.4 million euros (compared to 357.6 million euros or 11.9% of total imports with an increase of 1.0%).

During this period we have decreased imports in these groups: optical, medical, photographic, musical, etc. instruments in the amount of about 33.0 million euros (compared to 35.4 million euros or 1.1% of total imports with a decrease of 6.8%), and of various manufactured items in the amount of 88.2 million euros (compared to 90.9 million euros or 2.9% of total imports with a decrease of 3.0%).

#### International trade of goods with EU 28 countries

Kosovo's exports to EU-28 countries amounted to 94,2 million euros, or about (24.9%) of total exports, therefore up by 34.6%. The main partners for export of goods in EU are Germany 5.3%, Netherlands 3.4%, Great Britain 3.0%, and Bulgaria 2.4%.

According to chapters the highest participation of the EU countries are for the following groups: ores, colors and grain of 21,1 million euros or about (22.4% ), plastics and articles thereof of 15,6 million euros or about (16.6%), processed and unprocessed leather of 5.8 million euros or about (6.2%), etc.

Kosovo's imports from EU-28 countries amounted to 1,312,2 million euros or (43.1%) of total imports, up by 9.1%. The highest share of imports were from Germany (12.4%), Italy (6.4%), Greece (4.4%), Poland (2.6%) and Slovenia (2.1%).

EU countries cover most of Kosovo's total imports. Exports with the highest participation were in these chapters: various means of transport reaching 240,8 million euros, or around (18.4%), mineral fuels, mineral oils and their destination products, reaching 212,6 million euros, or about (16.2%), etc.

#### Trade with CEFTA countries

In 2017, Kosovo's exports to CEFTA countries amounted to 183,0 million euros, or (48.4%) of total exports, with an increase of (26.9%). The main partners for export in CEFTA countries are: Albania (15.9%), Serbia (12.8%), Macedonia (12.1%) and Montenegro (5.3%).

According to chapters, the highest participation of CEFTA countries have the following groups: mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their destination, totaling 32,6 million euros, or about (17.8%), iron and steel articles reaching to 22,7 million euros, or around (12.4%), etc.

While imports from CEFT countries in 2017 amounted to 856,1 million euros, or (28.1%) of total imports, up by (13.7%). The countries with the highest participation for import were: Serbia (14.8%), Macedonia (5.1%) and Albania (5.0%).

Highest imports were in these chapters: mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their destination, totaling 139,9 million euros , or about (16.3%), iron and steel, amounting to euro 133,7 million euros, or around (15.6%).

#### Trade with other countries of the world

Kosovo's exports to other countries reached 100,7 million euros, or (26.7%). The most important export partners are: India (13.9%), Switzerland (5.6%), and China (1.5%).

While Kosovo's imports to other countries reached 878,6 million euros, or (28.8%). The countries with the highest import share in this group were: Turkey (9.6%) and China (9.0%).

## Kosovo international trade statistics - methodological notes

### Resources

Trade statistics consist mainly of documents submitted to the customs authority by importers or exporters (or their agents). This document is a Single Customs Document (SCD), which is used for customs clearance purposes. Information from the document is transferred to the customs information system.

### Responsibilities for collecting, compiling and publishing data

The customs administration is responsible for collecting, entering and processing the customs statements data. Data in the field of statistics, which are registered in SCD, are reported at KAS on a monthly basis by Customs Administration, electronically.

KAS is responsible for processing and publishing Kosovo international trade data. These statistics include data by type of customs procedures. Additional work involves the correction and approval of customs data.

### Coverage

Kosovo international trade statistics do not include imports and exports of temporary goods which, in the unaltered state or condition, will be returned after a certain time, such as services, repairs, money in terms of wages, money in gold, supply of fuel of Kosovar vehicles abroad, import of goods for liaison offices and other diplomatic missions in Kosovo, personal luggage of passengers, commercial samples and low value mail packages.

### The registration system

Kosovo international trade statistics are compiled according to the "special" (facilitating definition) system of international trade registration. Under this system, imports and exports are recorded at a time when goods move through the territory under free flow, and this is the part where goods can be sold without customs restrictions. The facilitating definition implies that in addition to the regular export and import transactions, both external and internal processing is involved.

Special exports include exports of goods: exports after inward processing, exports for outward processing and exports that are not registered in customs.

Special imports consist of imports of goods from: imports for inward processing (S.S), imports after external processing, imports that are not registered in the customs.

Excluded are goods that are in transit.

### Estimation

For imports, the cif value (including cost, security and transport of goods at the entry point in Kosovo) is used. The export value is fob (free on board). This is the price of goods purchased abroad including packaging, transport within the country, the charge price, insurance and other costs incurred when the goods are placed on the vessel for export, on airplanes or transported to remote areas. The value of the invoice is recalculated to the value of the Kosovo border by adding or subtracting, in whole or in part, the costs of transport, loading, unloading, which depend on the terms of supply specified in the contract.

The value excludes:

" any amount received by the exporter on the route of reimbursement, reimbursement of the customs duty, subsidy or any other granted.

" any foreign customs duty or modification of the carriage of goods other than at the customs point or at the point of exportation.

The value is in euros. For transactions where the value is denominated in another currency, the euro exchange rate is made by using the weekly exchange rate.

Reference period

The calendar month is a basic time to collect the data. Based on customs data, the date of delivery of the customs statement or other valid dates for the implementation of the customs rules are the time to register the import / export transactions.

Quantity units

The quantity of imported and exported goods is shown net weight, if it can be determined, taking into account the nature of the product as well as the additional unit when described by the customs tariff nomenclature.

Net weight is the usual unit of the given quantity. The weight of containers, luggage, bottles and packing materials are excluded.

Other units of quantity used for some of the most important goods such as livestock, motors for vehicles, local equipment, watches, clothes (where the numbering unit is used), shoes (where the number of pairs is used), wrappings for the floor (where the square meter is used) and beverages (where volume is used).

Partner countries

In this publication, imports are registered by country of origin (as opposed to the country of destination). Goods obtained or produced in a country of origin but from the same country. A product in whose production are involved two or more countries, then as a country of origin is considered the country where the last major processing was made. Packaging, repackaging and classification are not considered as manufacturing processes.

Exports are classified by country of final destination. The last destination of goods is considered the last state for which the goods are intended. This does not mean that it is the country where the goods will be discharged or where the final consumption will be made.

Classification of the country

The country nomenclature is the classification of countries (geo-nomenclature), according to the Official Journal of the European Commission, published annually. Since January 1999, the United Nations' ISO alpha 2-digit system is used, where each state is identified by a figure composed of two-letters.

Classification of goods

Statistics are collected by using the Combined Nomenclature (CN) 8 digit - tariff and statistical nomenclature of the EU. This nomenclature is managed and updated annually by the Commission in cooperation with Member States. CN is aligned with the 6-digit system of the Harmonized System of Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) - the

Nomenclature of the Customs Council for Co-operation that is used throughout the world for applying customs tariffs and compiling international trade statistics. The CN contains about 10,400 sub-head 8-digit number, the first six digits are identical with the figures of the Harmonized System (HS).

The Standard Classification of Trade (SCT), revision No.3 (SSCT Rev 3) has been developed by the United Nations for advanced international comparability of international trade statistics.

Standard Classification of External Trade (SCET) Revision No.3 contains about 3,100 basic headings (5-digit). These are combined into 261 groups (3-digit), 98 divisions (2-digit) and 10 sections (1-digit). For example, Section 6 (manufactured goods classified mainly by material) consists of 9 Divisions, 61 to 69. Division 64 (paper, paperboard and articles thereof) consists of two groups, 641 and 642, which together consist of 72 basic headings, such as 642.94 (paper handkerchiefs, towels, tablecloths, and the like).

SCET Revision No.3 is identical to the structure of the Harmonized System. Each of the categories in the SCET (including all the basic headings) is equivalent to a combination of HS headings (and therefore to a combination of CN headings).

#### Publication of data

Monthly data are provisional and are published 30 days after the reference month.  
Annual data are published in June.

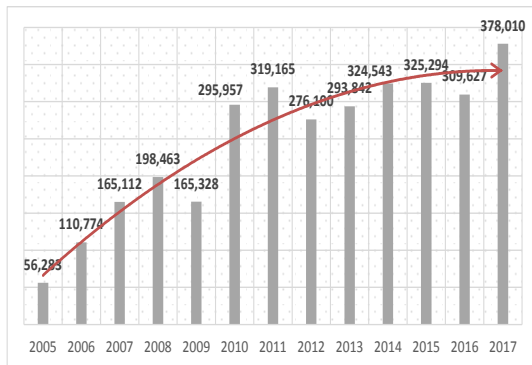
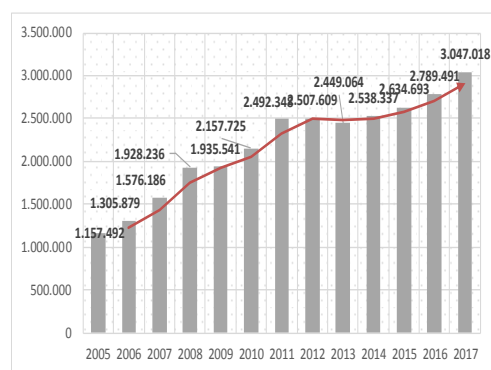

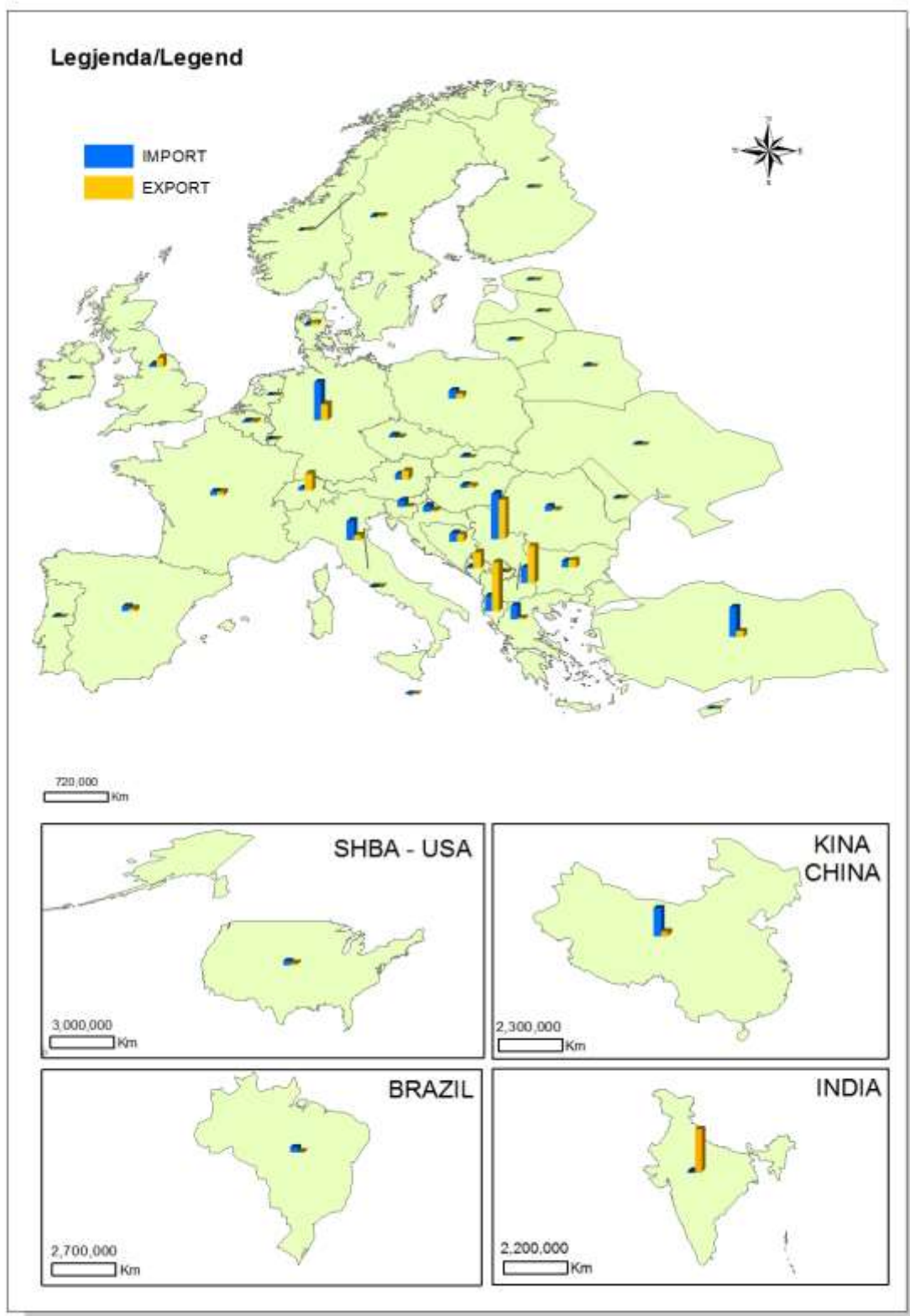

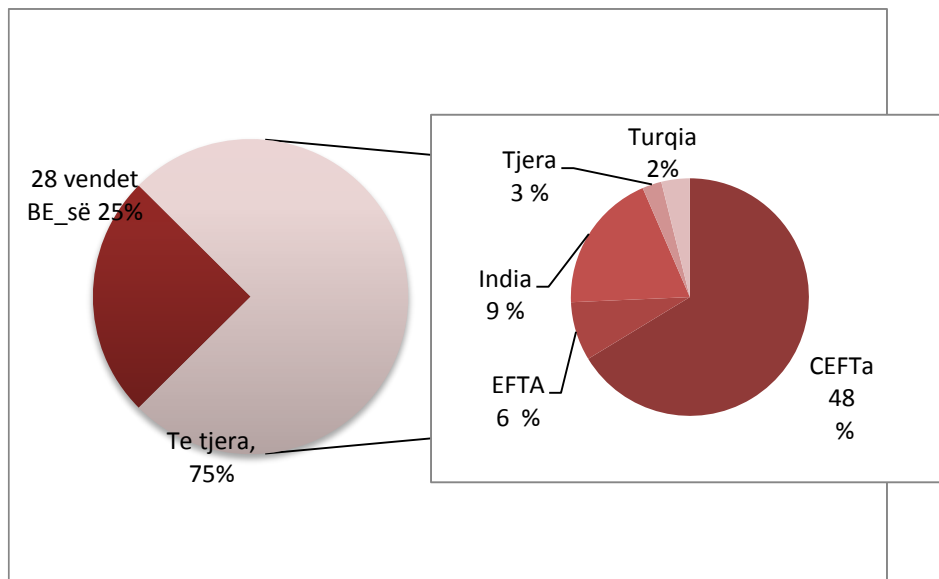

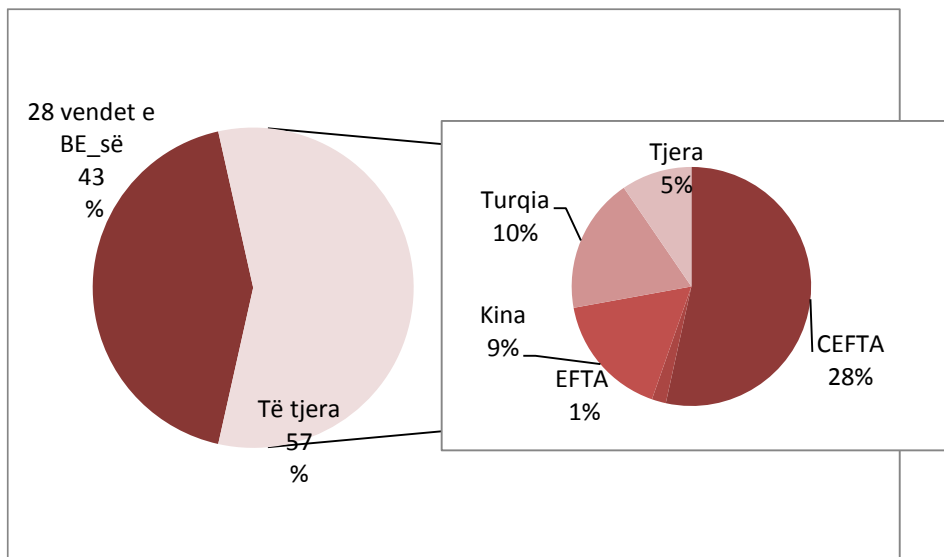

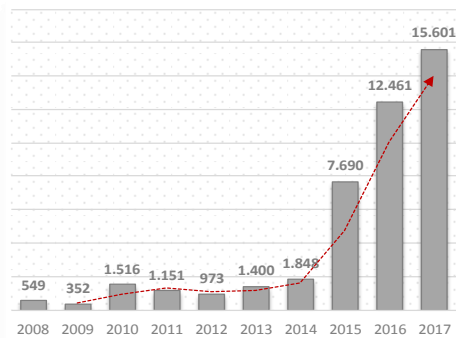

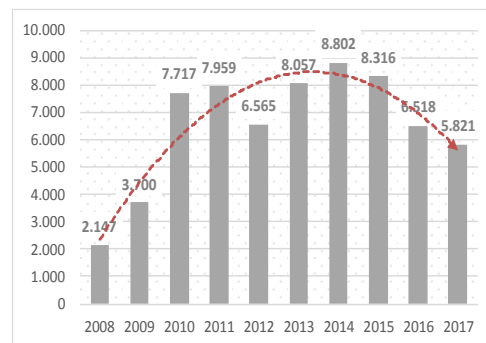

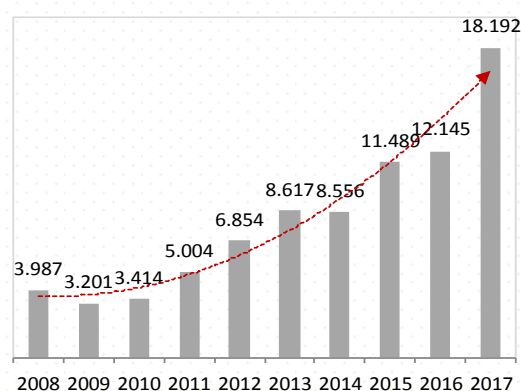

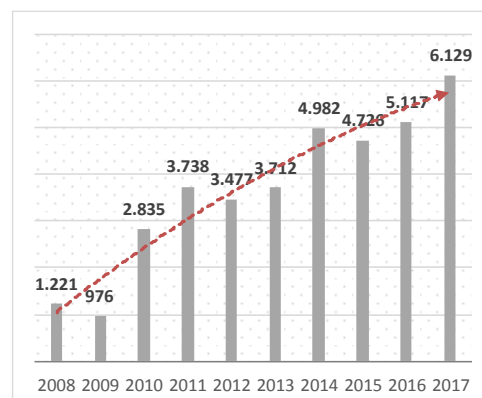

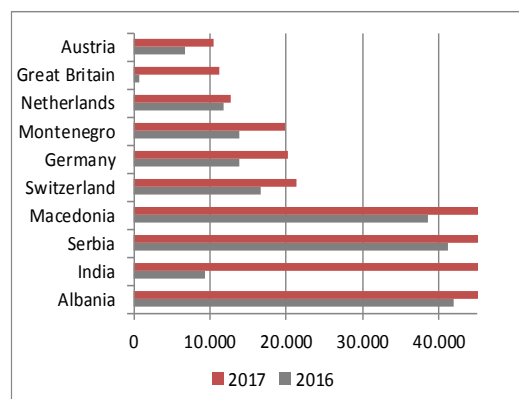
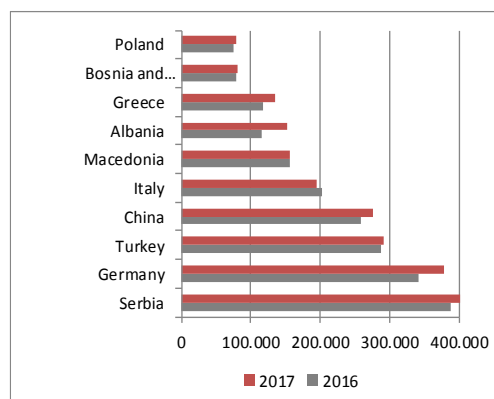
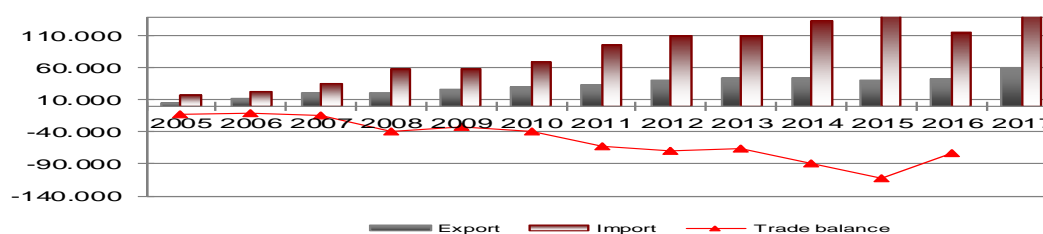
**Graph 9: Export by country, 2016-2017****Graph 10: Import by country, 2016-2017**

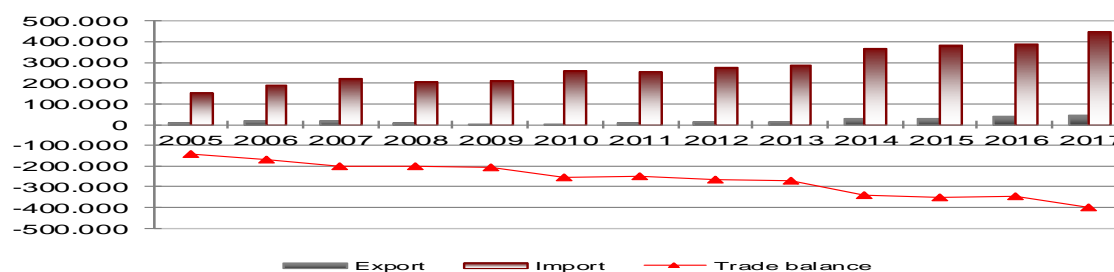

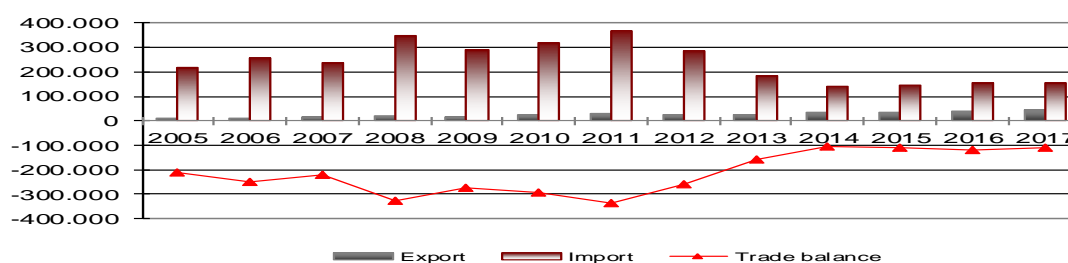

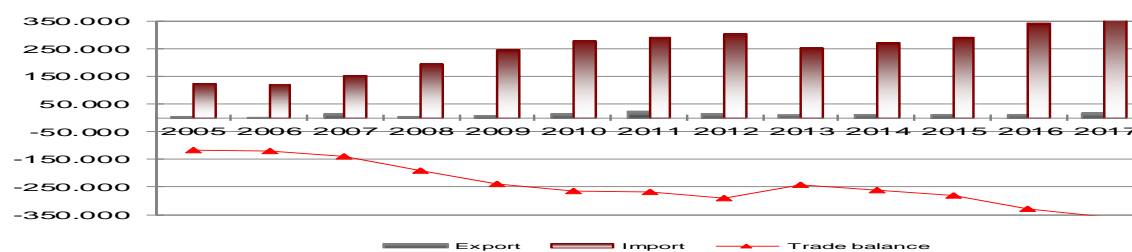

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# Kosovo Agency of Statistics

## *short description*

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Agency has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Since 12.12.2011 the Agency operates in the frames of the Prime Minister's Office. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** acts according to the Law No. 04/L-036 which entered into force on 12.12.2011. Programme of Official Statistics 2018/2022 is in implementation for the development of statistical system in correlation with the European Union statistics (EUROSTAT).

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** has this organizational structure: production departments; (Department of Economic statistics and National Accounts, Department of Agriculture and Environment statistics and Department of Social statistics. **Support Departments**; Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Policy Planning, Coordination and Communication, Department of Census and survey and Department of Administration. **Within the Agency are also established Regional Offices**; Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Pristina and Ferizaj

In KAS are employed in total 155 workers, of whom 100 (68,0 %) at the headquarters of the Agency, while in the Regional Offices, 47 (32,0%). Agency's educational qualifying structure is as follows: 75,5% with university education, 12,3% with with non-tertiary education, and 12.3% with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all Ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNICEF, and with the statistical institutions of the countries in the region.

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

In 2011, the project of Population Census , Households and Dwellings was successfully implemented, and in 2014 was successfully carried out the Agriculture Census. The result obtained from these censuses will have an important role in the development policies.

**The mission of the Agency**; to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.

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
